HOW TO CHECK OFFICIAL GRADES AFTER THE SEMESTER

Fall grades will be available to view through your Student Center on January 7, 2022. Dates are subject to change so refer to the [Registrar's website](#).

There are multiple ways to check grades through your [Student Center](#) using the "other academic" pull-down menu.

- ✓ **Unofficial Transcript (academic history)** – View semester grades, units earned, and GPAs (term, cumulative, SF State)
- ✓ **Degree Progress Report** – Determine which requirements you completed (some have a minimum grade requirement)
- ✓ **Grades** – View a snapshot of semester grades by term

WINTER SESSION Q&A

- Q:** WHAT IS WINTER SESSION?
- A:** Winter Session 2022 is an optional, three-week session (Dec. 22 to Jan. 18) that provides an opportunity to earn up to 4 units of credit toward your degree (i.e. complete a GE course). Since the session is shorter than fall or spring terms, expect an intense, fast-paced learning experience that requires you to participate and/or work on assignments each day of the winter session.
- Q:** WHAT ARE THE FEES AND DOES FINANCIAL AID COVER WINTER SESSION?
- A:** Winter Session 2022 course fees are \$360/unit (\$1080 for a 3-unit course) and financial aid is not available.
- Q:** HOW DO I ENROLL?
- A:** Students enroll through the [College of Extended Learning](#). Be sure to review the [important dates and deadlines](#) and keep in mind that you will only have the first day of instruction to decide if you want to add/drop a course.
